To properly place an e-collar on your pet

The cone should be at least an inch past the nose of your pet. This is measured from the point of the cone resting at the base of the neck while your pet's head is upright. If the cone is shorter than that, the potential exists that your pet will be able to get the area in question.

The loops at the base of the cone are there for the pet's collar to go through. This is how you will secure the cone to your pet.

Once you have put the collar through the loops, secure the cone to your pet. If you can slide two fingers under the collar then your pet will be able to swallow and eat without troubles. If you are able to place more than two fingers under the collar, it will most likely be too loose and your pet might be able to get the cone off.



The cone is to stay on the pet for at least 10 days. When you remove the cone after the required time, make sure your pet does not go to the affected area and start to lick. Should this happen, place the cone back on for another 3 days.

←The collar is through the small loops at the base of the cone.
